3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Air Traffic Controller

6 SEC. 2. REDUCTION, REPLACEMENT, OR OUTSOURCE OF

FAA STAFFING.

8 (a) REDUCTION IN STAFFING.—

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(1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other
 provision of law, in order for the Secretary of Trans portation to reduce, replace, or outsource 1 percent
 or more of the workforce of the Federal Aviation
 Administration, the Secretary shall obtain explicit
 approval from Congress.

7 (2) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Before seeking ap-8 proval from Congress under paragraph (1), the Sec-9 retary of Transportation shall submit to Congress a 10 report detailing the rationale for any decision to re-11 duce, replace, or outsource 1 percent or more of the 12 workforce of the Federal Aviation Administration as 13 well as any analysis on how such decision will impact 14 the aviation and transportation system at large.

(b) DOGE CONTROL.—The Administrator of the Department of Governmental Efficiency may not exercise
control over the Federal Aviation Administration.

(c) ATC PRIVATIZATION.—Notwithstanding any
other provision of law, the air traffic control system of
the Federal Aviation Administration may not be privatized
or outsourced from the Federal Aviation Administration.
