Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:


I am requesting funding for the City of Upland Foothill Boulevard Street Rehabilitation Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Upland, located at 460 North Euclid Avenue, Upland, California 91786.

The funding would be used to help rehabilitate 2,700 linear feet of Foothill Boulevard between Central Avenue and Benson Avenue and restore the corridor to a state of good repair, and build Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant pedestrian facilities. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because Foothill Boulevard, part of the historic Route 66, serves approximately 26,000 vehicles daily is deteriorating and the rehabilitation project would support regional mobility, local commerce, transit access, and emergency response, while preventing structural failure, higher costs, and increased safety risks.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by: 23 USC 133.
