3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting America"
5 Cybersecurity Act".

2 SEC. 2. REINSTATEMENT AND LIMITATION ON REMOVAL OF 2 CISA EMPLOYEES. 3 (a) Reinstatement.—Any individual who was involuntarily removed from a position in the Cybersecurity and 4 5 Infrastructure Security Agency between the period beginning on January 25, 2025, and ending on March 1, 2025 6 7 shall, at the election of such individual, be reinstated to 8 the individual's former position with backpay in accord-9 ance with section 5596 of title 5, United States Code. 10 (b) Limitations on Reduction in Resources.— No employee may be involuntarily removed from, or trans-11 ferred to a position outside of, the Cybersecurity and In-12 frastructure Security Agency, and no appropriations avail-13 able for the Agency may be impounded, transferred, or reprogrammed unless Congress enacts a law after the date 15 of the enactment of this Act providing for such a removal 16 17 or transfer, unless such transfer authority is specifically provided by Acts making appropriations for the Agency. 18 19 (c) Exceptions.—Subsection (a) shall not apply to 20 any individual removed from a political position, any indi-

tion in subsection (b) on removal and transfer of employ-

vidual involuntarily removed for misconduct or delin-

quency, or any individual involuntarily removed and whose

most recent performance review before such removal was

unacceptable or less than fully successful, and the limita-

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1	ees shall not apply to any employee occupying a political
2	position.
3	(d) POLITICAL POSITION DEFINED.—In this section,
4	the term "political position" means —
5	(1) a position described under sections 5312
6	through 5316 of title 5, United States Code (relat-
7	ing to the Executive Schedule);
8	(2) an individual in a Senior Executive Service
9	position who is not a career appointee (as that term
10	is defined under section 3132(a) of such title); or
11	(3) a position in the executive branch of the
12	Government of a confidential or policy-determining
13	character under schedule C of subpart C of part 213
14	of title 5, Code of Federal Regulations.
15	SEC. 3. LIMITATION ON DOGE EMPLOYEES WORKING AT
16	CISA.
17	No Federal funds may be obligated or expended for
18	the salary or expenses of any employee of the Department
19	of the United States DOGE Service (commonly referred
20	to as the "Department of Government Efficiency" or
21	"DOGE") or any employee of a DOGE agency team
22	transferred, detailed, or otherwise working at the Cyberse-
23	curity and Infrastructure Security Agency.
