4 This Act may be cited as the "Thriving Communities

6 SEC. 2. THRIVING COMMUNITIES PROGRAM.

- 7 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—The Secretary of Transpor-

 capacity building to help the fastest growing communities
 advance transformative infrastructure projects.

5 (b) REPORT.—The Secretary shall submit to the

8 (1) the methods the Secretary uses in carrying

(2) the level of coordination between the Secretary of Transportation and the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development in carrying out such
program, including the respective roles of each Secretary; and

18 (c) AUTHORIZATIONS OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There19 is authorized to be appropriated for each fiscal year—

20 (1) \$100,000,000 to the Secretary of Transpor21 tation to carry out this section; and

(2) \$5,500,000 million to the Secretary of
Housing and Urban Development to facilitate coordination with the Secretary of Transportation to
carry out this section.
